IDA is an educational service centre that provides information, advice, and training on the topics of (anti-)racism, right-wing extremism and populism, antisemitism, anti-racist organisational development, education in post-migration society, diversity, (anti-)discrimination and flight and asylum.

Numerous associations, institutions, non-governmental organisations, and state agencies engage in issues of right-wing extremism and populism, racism, migration, or diversity in their work. Youth organisations address racism in society and within their own organisations, organise international encounters, conduct anti-racism trainings, seek ways to implement anti-racist organisational development, or initiate cultural inclusion development. Initiatives work locally for diversity, democracy, and an open society while opposing racism, right-wing extremism, right-wing populism, and discrimination. Young people from immigrant families seek information and support to form associations, campaign against racism and discrimination, empower themselves, and demand recognition within youth work structures and wider society.

To support these activities, the Information and Documentation Centre for Anti-Racism Work (IDA e.V.) promotes anti-racist and diversity inclusive approaches and methods in youth work and civic education, initiates projects, and fosters networking among those active in these fields. IDA offers consultation, publications and training seminars to organisations of youth from immigrant families to support their work.

IDA is funded by the Federal Ministry for Education, Family Affairs, Senior Citizens, Women and Youth.

Information, Documentation and Consultation

🌀 **IDA** provides information about key topics in the areas of (anti-)racism, right-wing extremism and populism, antisemitism, anti-racist organisational development, diversity, equity and inclusion, (anti-)discrimination, flight and asylum, and education in post-migration society;

🌀 **IDA** recommends speakers, trainers and moderators for events. IDA staff members are also available for these activities;

🌀 **IDA** assists in building contacts with organisations, associations, self-organisations, initiatives, state agencies, scientific institutions, etc.;

🌀 **IDA** collects information on the mentioned topics in its magazine and organisation archives and specialised library and hosts the Vielfalt-Mediathek, that pools the publications created within the federal programme “Demokratie leben!” (“Live Democracy!”) in an online archive and app;

🌀 **IDA** provides consultation for youth organisations, projects, processes of anti-racist organisational and cultural inclusion development and event organisers;

🌀 **IDA** presents relevant information about IDA's work and selected thematic areas on the website www.IDAeV.de;

🌀 **IDA** informs through the regularly published online newsletter IDA-Infomail, about IDA activities, its member associations, news, events, and new publications in IDA's thematic areas, with special consideration of youth-specific aspects;

🌀 **IDA** advises multipliers and organisations active in IDA's areas of focus.

Education

🌀 **IDA** regularly offers educational events (conferences, seminars, workshops, trainings) for professionals and volunteers in youth work and civic education;

🌀 **IDA** organises qualification seminars for active members of organisations of youth associations from immigrant families and supports them in building effective association structures;

🌀 **IDA** advises and supports youth associations and youth councils in anti-racist organisational and cultural inclusion development;

🌀 **IDA** acts as a connection between the scientific community and practical youth work and education.

Publications

🌀 **IDA** publishes target group-specific readers comprised of scientific and practical articles on current topics and debates and educational materials for youth work;

🌀 **IDA** publishes flyers that comprehensibly and precisely explain key terms and topics;

🌀 **IDA** provides issue-specific directories on speakers and trainers, films and videos, and educational materials on its website;

🌀 **IDA** offers all the publications and various texts on anti-racism, diversity and inclusion, anti-racist organisational and cultural inclusion development, antisemitism, flight and asylum, and education in post-migration society as free downloads on the website;

🌀 **IDA** hosts the Vielfalt-Mediathek, an online archive and app that pools the publications created within the federal programme “Live Democracy!” and past federal programs against right-wing extremism, racism, and antisemitism, and makes them available for download at www.vielfalt-mediathek.de.
